25. Picnic table shaded by *Acacia catenulata* (Bendee)  
Note row of *Eucalyptus youngiana*
26. *Banksia ashbyi*, *Eucalyptus grossa*
27. Western Walk – park and wander through this section. *Grevillea caleyi*, *Banksia blechnifolia*, *Gossypium sturtianum*
28. *Grevillea glauca*, *Babingtonia jucunda*, *Grevillea longistyla*, *Acacia rhodophloia* (a minnaritchie species) *Acacia craspedocarpa*.
29. *Grevillea insignis*, *Kunzea pulchella*, *Grevillea disjuncta*, *Grevillea dimidiata*
30. *Grevillea tetragonoloba* with tooth brush flowers
31. Gordon Grevillea Walk – Original 'Robyn' and 'Sandra' plants. Look for the parent grevilleas.
32. *Calothamnus* spp., *Calytrix tenuifolia*, *Eucalyptus formanii*, *Cassia brewsteri*
33. Gumnut Walk – *Eucalyptus burracoppinensis*, *E. kingsmillii*, *E. youngiana*, *Melaleuca* sp. Griman Creek (local species), *E. crucis*. Keep walking south and find *E. wandoo*.
34. *Eucalyptus pyriformis*, *E. angustissima*
35. Honeyeater Walk
36. Retained local species
37. Grevillea hybrid gardens established by Society for Growing Australian Plants members
38. Chinchilla white gum grove *Eucalyptus argophloia*

Myall Park Botanic Garden conserves and displays species from arid, semi-arid and dry tropical regions with an emphasis on rare, threatened and vulnerable species. Many species are ex-situ, naturally occurring from other regions of Australia.

Natural bushland setting on a red lateritic ridge from 366 metres above sea level.

Owned by a non-profit company, development and restoration of the Garden are carried out as funds permit.

1. Start of the Lake View Trail.
2. Grevillea species gardens – listen for the variety of birds during early morning and evening
3. Plants painted by Dorothy Gordon are established in these gardens
4. Site for proposed waterfall and end of Lake View Trail
5. This Garden section is unmown to preserve natural grasses
6. *Eucalyptus pachyphylla* (was Dave Gordon's favourite)
7. Terpersie Cottage garden features eremophilas, Gordon hybrid grevilleas
8. *Acacia wardellii* (local rare species), prostrate *Banksia gardneri*, *Grevillea dielsiana*
9. *Ricinocarpus bowmannii* (threatened), *Melaleuca arenaria*
10. Avochie Cottage garden established by Chinchilla Field Naturalists' Club members
11. Start of Chinchilla White Gums Trail
12. Old Eucalypt Way
13. Retained grove of *Angophora leiocarpa*
14. *Allocasuarina inophloia* (Threadybark oak)
15. *Eucalyptus eudesmioides* - Dorothy called this the 'Children's Tree'
16. Numerous eremophila species
17. All Seasons Walk
18. Scaly leafed melaleuca species
19. End of Chinchilla White Gums Trail
20. Row of *Hakea lorea*. Artists enjoy the 'bonsai' shapes
21. *Grevillea* 'Merinda Gordon' (*G. insignis* x *G. asteriscosa*)  
Note *Eucalyptus salubris*

\* NO smoking, open fires or barbecues. Fire danger is HIGH

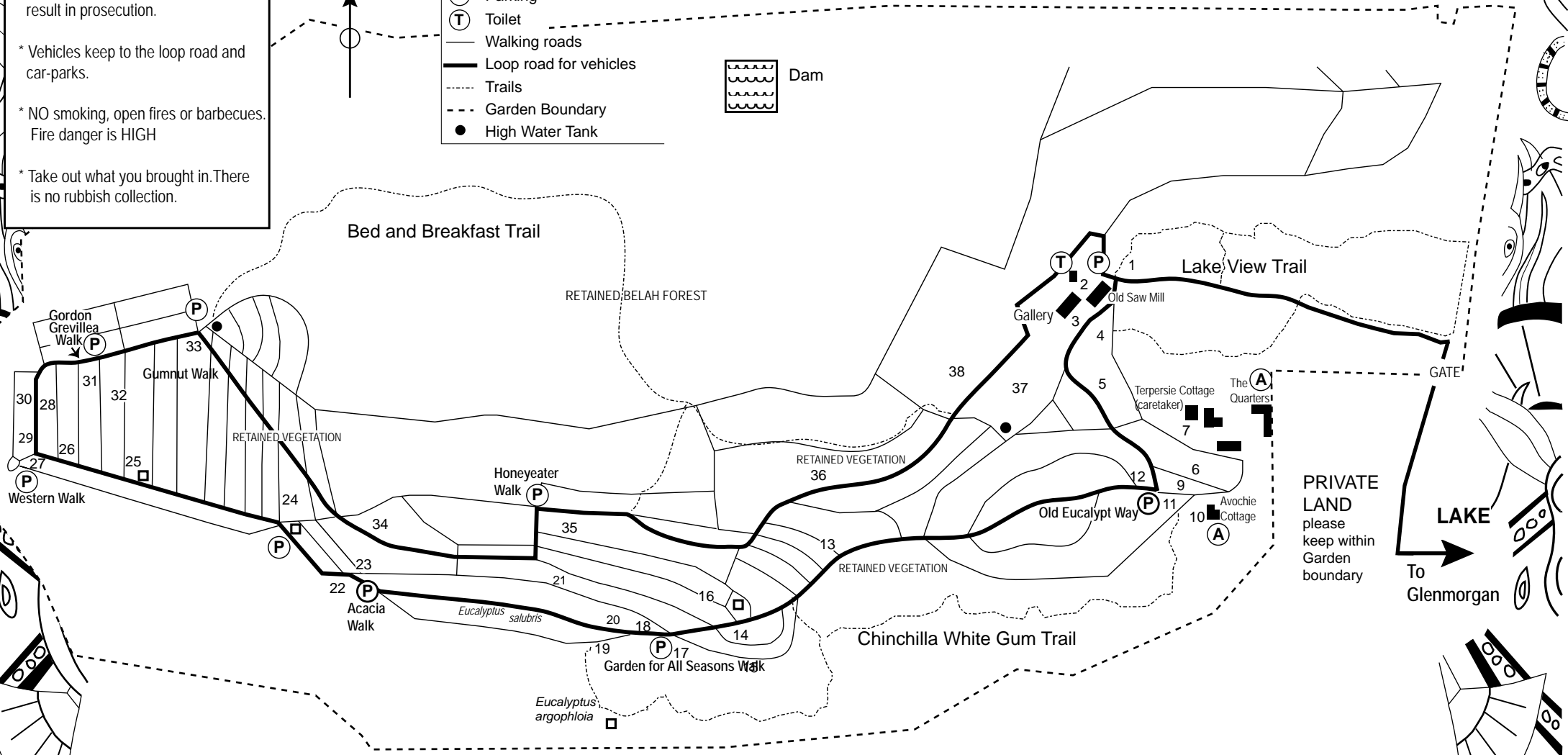
